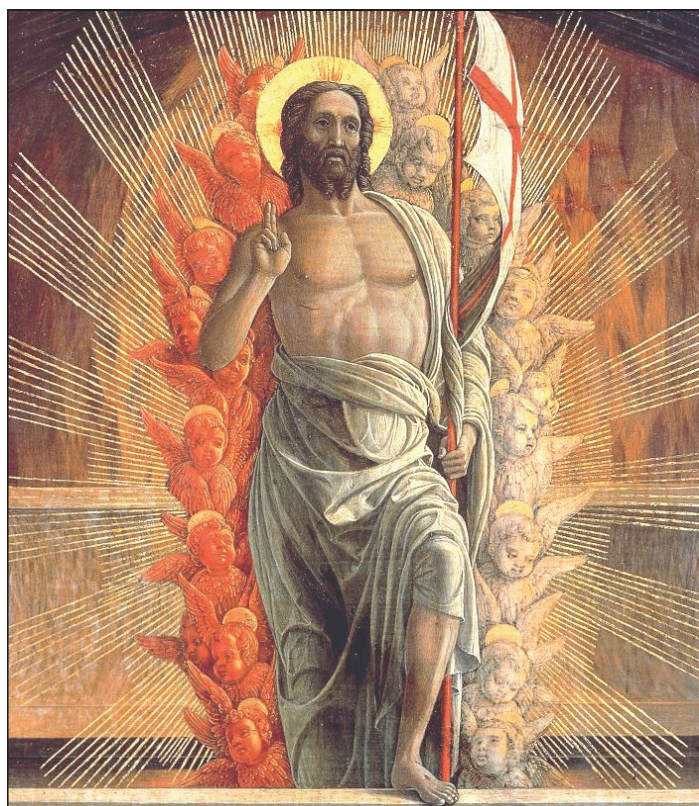

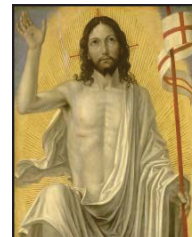

### Confirmation Crash Course



Are you an adult who is baptized Catholic, made Confession and received First Holy Communion, but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation? If so, prayerfully consider attending our

**CONFIRMATION CRASH COURSE** on Thursdays, **April 28 and May 5, 19 and 26**, from 6 to 7 p.m. in the Saint Joseph Room in the Basilica of Saint Mary Lyceum (313 Duke Street). Adult Confirmation will take place with Bishop Burbidge on **June 5** at the Cathedral of Saint Thomas More in Arlington.

Before being accepted into the course, candidates are to live in parish boundaries; be a registered member; attend Sunday Mass weekly; meet with Religious Education staff for a 30-minute in-take interview; meet with a priest if engaged to be married, not married by the Church or previously married; if married, provide the marriage certificate; submit their Catholic baptismal certificate, with notations, dated in the last six months; secure a Catholic-in-good standing to serve as their sponsor; and choose a Confirmation Saint name.

## Q & A Exploring & Practicing Our Catholic Faith

### Q: What is the Paschal Candle?

A: The Paschal – or Easter – Candle is a large candle made of beeswax to indicate the sinless Christ, our Risen Savior and the Light of the World.

At the start of the Easter Vigil Mass, a new fire, symbolizing our eternal life in Christ, is kindled outside the church and used to light the Paschal Candle. The candle is blessed by the priest who then inscribes in it the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet, *Alpha* and *Omega*, “the beginning and the end,” along with the current year. He also embeds five grains of incense into the candle, recalling the aromatic spices with which Christ’s body was prepared for the tomb, and of the five wounds in His hands, feet and side. The candle is then carried in procession into the darkened church and used to light smaller candles held by the faithful, illuminating the entire church with the Light of Christ. The Paschal Candle is then used to bless the water to be used in baptisms at that Mass.

The Easter candle is lighted each day for Mass throughout the Easter season. During the rest of the liturgical year, we light the Paschal Candle for baptisms, weddings and funerals.

## FROM THE ARCHIVES

*A periodic look at the history of our Basilica of Saint Mary parish since its founding in 1795*



### SAINT MARY AND WORLD WAR II

By the late 1930s, concerns were growing over the situation in Central Europe. One often-asked question was, "Should American Catholics support communist Russia to suppress Nazi Germany?" The debate became academic when Pearl Harbor was attacked on the first Sunday in December 1941.

Saint Mary parish wholeheartedly supported the war effort. Even before Pearl Harbor, Alexandria's Catholics had seen the need to provide opportunities for entertainment and relaxation for the many servicemen from Fort Belvoir who flocked to Alexandria on weekends. Many could not afford to visit the evening attractions of Washington, DC, so Saint Mary volunteers worked with the National Catholic Community Service (NCCS) to host a canteen for the GIs in the Knights of Columbus building on Cameron Street. The local moderator of the NCCS was Father Joseph L. Leitch, assistant pastor of Saint Mary.

In April 1944, as the nation awaited the invasion of Europe (then called "I-Day"), Bishop Peter L. Ireton called for each parish to recite the rosary daily for members of the armed forces, living or dead, and for a quick peace; designate May 7-14 as National Family Week, with special programs to "renew the ideals of Catholic family life"; hold services at 8 p.m. on D-Day, joining all churches and synagogues in the nation to pray simultaneously for the success of the invasion of Europe.

Saint Mary was involved in these and other wartime, home-front activities. In addition to the special prayers and services, the parish participated in bond sales, air raid drills, Red Cross volunteer work and collected clothing for displaced persons through the War Relief Services of the National Catholic Welfare Conference. — *Kitty Guy, Parish Historian*

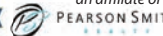
