If <u>Fairfax County Public Schools</u> are <u>CLOSED</u> for activities then there will be no NVJCYO games—regardless of county or other jurisdiction where the game was to be played.

If <u>Fairfax County Public Schools</u> are <u>OPEN</u> for activities then NVJCYO will play games <u>EXCEPT</u>:

• Games to be played at Our Lady of Hope and St. Theresa in Loudon County and St. Francis in Prince William County may be cancelled even if Fairfax is open because those areas may experience different weather. If Fairfax schools are open then you should check the closing information for Loudon and Prince William... if they are closed, NVJCYO games will not be held at those locations.

Coaches will be notified by their commissioner of weather-related cancellations and delays as soon as possible. Decisions to close gyms will also be posted to this website as soon as possible-but communications from a league's commissioner to the coaches should be considered the most up-to-date. As always, parents and guardians should use their best judgment regarding safety conditions, regardless of decisions made by the league.
