Liturgical Calendar This Week

- September 20. Saints Andrew Kim Tae-gon, Priest, Paul Chong Ha-Sang and Companions, Martyrs. Andrew was a convert and first Korean-born Catholic priest. Tortured, beheaded in 1846, along with seminarian Paul Chong Ha-Sang. From 1839-67, 103 martyrs died for the faith in Korea.
- September 21. Saint Matthew, Apostle, Evangelist, Martyr. According to the Gospel, Matthew was working as a tax collector in Capernaum when Christ said, "Follow me." With this simple call, Matthew's life changed and he became a disciple of Christ.
- September 23. Saint Pius of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio), Priest. Capuchin priest who received the miraculous stigmata. Spent 50 years in the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo, serving many as a spiritual advisor and confessor. He died on September 23, 1968.

Q & A Exploring & Practicing Our Catholic Faith

Q: I've heard the word "cloister" used when describing the life of some nuns. What does it mean?

A: A "cloister" is a place of religious seclusion. Members of a cloistered order limit their interaction with the world, remaining behind closed doors of a monastery for the most part, where they lead a life dedicated to prayer, work, fasting and meditation. Their's is a contemplative life, occupied with God and things of the spirit.

Cloistered communities of religious women in our general area include the Poor Clare Monastery of Mary, Mother of the Church, near Saint Louis Church here in Alexandria (https://poorclaresofalexandria.org/), the Dominican Sisters of Saint Dominic Monastery in Linden, VA (https://www.lindenopnuns.org/) and the Sisters of the Visitation of Holy Mary at the Monastery of Monte Maria near Richmond, VA (https://www.visitmontemaria.com/).

NEW BASILICA CHILDREN'S CHOIR SCHOOL

"I will sing to the Lord all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live" (Psalm 104:33)



The Saint Gregory Children's Choir School at the Basilica of Saint Mary is a new four-year program of comprehensive musical training and immersion into the Catholic choral tradition. Over the course of the program, students will learn to read music fluently and sing with confidence everything from Gregorian chant to modern compositions. Students also will learn music theory according the curriculum of the Royal College of Music in Toronto. Each year students will increasingly participate in the liturgical life of the Basilica and sing for concerts and other parish events. Plans for a choral trip will be developed.

Enrollment is open to any Catholic boy or girl, ages 8-12. Children do not need to be a student at the Basilica School of Saint Mary or a parishioner at the Basilica. No prior musical training is required. Practices take place twice per week, from 4 to 5 p.m. on Thursdays and from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays. For our inaugural year, there will be open enrollment for the months of **September and October**.

FROM THE ARCHIVES A periodic look at the history of our Basilica of Saint Mary parish

A periodic look at the history since its founding in 1795



A NEW DIOCESE

As the Catholic population of Virginia grew in the mid-20th century, especially in our northern part of the commonwealth, the diocese became too large. Rumors of a split were common by the early 1970s. Following the retirement of Bishop John J. Russell, the rumors became reality.

In 1972, the priests of the Alexandria and Arlington Deaneries asked Bishop John J. Russell, Richmond 's 10th Bishop, to initiate the process of establishing a new diocese in their part of the Commonwealth.



As a result, the Diocese of Arlington was established on August 13, 1974. Bishop Thomas J. Welsh, auxiliary of Philadelphia and rector of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary in Overbrook, PA, was installed as the first Bishop of Arlington. Auxiliary Bishop Walter J. Sullivan (1928-2021) was named Bishop of Richmond, and Bishop Thomas J. Welsh (1921-2009) was named the first Bishop of Arlington. In 1974, the new Diocese of Arlington had more than 136,000 Catholics, 60 diocesan and 33 religious priests, 49 parishes and 7 missions. Priests of Virginia could choose to serve in either diocese. Fortunately for the parishioners of Saint Mary, their beloved pastor, Father Joseph L. Wingler, chose to remain at Saint Mary.

At the time, there as much speculation that Saint Mary Church, the oldest parish in the Commonwealth of Virginia, would be named the cathedral for the new diocese. But because of practical reasons – Saint Mary lacked the needed extra office space and had very limited parking – Saint Thomas More Church in Arlington was elevated as the new diocesan cathedral.

As in 1891, when the Jesuits who had served in Alexandria for decades left the parish, life at Saint Mary went on uninterrupted by the change. – Kitty Guy, Parish Historian




